

An old-time railway, evocative of the Belle-Époque, transports you on a rattling journey through a dreamlike landscape - as you savour a majestic mountain panorama along the way. Once at the summit, take your pick of the many hiking routes, then enjoy a hearty meal at the restaurant. Tip: Admire 650 different plant species in the Alpine Garden.

THRILL WALK at Birg.

The views across the Swiss Alps from the viewing platform are nothing short of inspirational. Feel the appeal of an unparalleled world of adventure around two tranquil mountain lakes. Explore diversified hiking trails, soak up the sun on the viewing terrace or get your adrenalin kick with bungee jumping.



Three-gondola arrangements transports you upwards at a leisurely pace as dreamlike views unfold. Once at the summit of the Niederhorn, you are spoilt for choice: embark on a hike, go wildlife watching, master Alpine orienteering or race down the mountain on a scooter. You decide what memory to take



Standing on the spectacular Two Lakes Bridge of Interlaken's local mountain, the Harder Kulm, guests are guaranteed unparalleled views of Interlaken and the glorious sweep of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau; the shimmering lakes of Thun and Brienz make this a picture-perfect moment. Meanwhile fine Swiss dishes are served at the restaurant.

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Ballenberg Open-Air Museum

Familiar aromas of kitchens and parlours, the merry bleating of goats in the meadows and traditional crafts wherever you look ... Keep your eyes open as you walk around, and you will learn a great deal. Step by step, you travel deeper into Swiss history as you experience the rural Switzerland of a bygone time.

☐ Travel time from Interlaken (one way): 45 mins



With turquoise waters, mighty mountain peaks and a cool breeze in your face, a leisurely cruise on the lake against the mountainous backdrop of the Bernese Oberland makes for an unforgettable experience. Let your thoughts drift as the stunning natural surroundings glide by.

Alternatively Travel time from Interlaken (one way): 10 mins



Explore the interior of the mountain on a properly maintained and well-lit path that extends for around one kilometre. See stalactites and stalagmites that have taken millions of years to form as you venture deeper into a unique natural world. You can also visit the caves museum to learn more about the world of caves.

Want to see and experience how knights and damsels lived in the olden days? You may not be able to live in the fairytale castles that stand around Lake Thun, but you can at least catch a scent of aristocratic air by visiting the historic interiors for a unique insight.

Alternatively Travel time from Interlaken (one way): 30-45 mins




